

Installation Guidelines

Installation advice for Roolf Luxury Vinyl Flooring

Thank you for choosing Roolf, the stylish, tough and easy to fit floor coverings. Just follow the instructions below. Enjoy the benefits that our Luxury flooring brings to you.

Installation Procedures

- Open several cartons and mix them as they are installed to help blend any slight differences in shade. Inspect each tile for visual defects before installing.
- Installation of flooring implies acceptance of materials.
- It is advised to plan the layout of the room prior to installation. Divide the room to make installation easier and more balanced layout.
- Make sure that the Roolf, adhesive and sub floor to a stable condition in the range of 59°F (15°C) to 80.6°F (27°C) and humidity 75% for a minimum of 48 hours before, during and 24 hours after installation. For the most optimum results and in particular for extreme temperature conditions, increase the duration to a minimum of 48 hours.
- It is highly suggested that throughout service life, the floor should remain in the temperature range of 59°F (15°C) to 80.6°F (27°C).
- Apply the recommended adhesive in which is suitable for PVC and use according to the manufacturer instructions. Adhesive selection should also be appropriated for site conditions. ROOLF will not be responsible for any installation complaints if a non-recommended adhesive is used.
- We suggest apply a protective coating to ensure long lasting ROOLF floor. Using a suitable tool, evenly apply a first coat of coating on the surface of the floor, within 200 mm of the skirting. Remember to apply in alternate directions; last coat must cover the floor up to the skirting.
- Within 1 hour after the installation the floor must be rolled using a 45 kgs (100 lbs.) 3-section roller in both directions.
- Wait 24 hours after installation to resume normal foot traffic and under floor heating. 48 hours before washing finished floors with neutral cleaning products, Dilute PU-cleaner with water (1:10) remove the dirty water with a broom, mop, or a wet/steam vacuum cleaner and then rinse with clean water.
